In Artramon you can enjoy challenging driven pheasant and duck, walked up shooting; pigeon flighting; wild duck shooting or indeed a day on the World Famous North Slob, home to some of the most challenging wildfowling.

On 4 May 1951, Sir Hugh Beaver, then the managing director of the Guinness Breweries, went on a shooting party in the North Slob. He became involved in an argument over which was the fastest game bird in Europe, the koshin golden plover or the grouse. That evening at Castlebridge House he realised that it was impossible to confirm in reference books whether or not the golden plover was Europe’s fastest game bird. Beaver knew that there must be numerous other questions debated nightly in pubs throughout Ireland and Britain, but there was no book in the world with which to settle arguments about records. He realised then that a book supplying the answers to this sort of question

might prove popular. The Idea of “The Guinness Book of Records” was born and first published in 1955. It’s a bestseller up to date.
